Andris Piebalgs took up the post of Energy Commissioner in November 2004, after being head of the Cabinet of the Latvian Commissioner to the European Union from May-October 2004. Before joining the European Commission, Mr. Piebalgs held diplomatic posts in the Latvian Government, serving as Undersecretary of State for EU Affairs (2003-04), Ambassador of Latvia to the European Union (1998-03), and Ambassador to Estonia (1995-97). Mr. Piebalgs also held the positions of Minister of Finance of Latvia (1994-95), Chairman of the Budget and Finance Committee in the Latvian Parliament (1993-94), and Minister of Education (1990-93).
