**Rawi Abdelal** is an assistant professor at Harvard Business School in the area of Business, Government, and the International Economy. He is also a faculty associate at Harvard's Davis Center for Russian Studies and the Weatherhead Center for International Affairs. His main area of expertise is international political economy.

In 1999 Abdelal earned a Ph.D. in Government from Cornell University, where he had received an M.A. in 1997. He was a President's Scholar at the Georgia Institute of Technology, where he received a B.S. with highest honors in Economics in 1993.

Professor Abdelal's current research explores how nationalism has affected the economic relations among post-Soviet states. In addition, he studies the reorganization of the post-Soviet regional economy in comparison to that of other post-imperial regions in history.

Professor Abdelal's book new book, *National Purpose in the World Economy: Post-Soviet States in Comparative Perspective*, will be published in autumn 2001.
